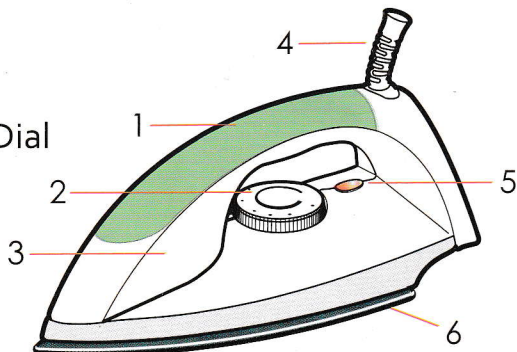

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

1. The iron should always be turned to MIN. before plugging or unplugging from socket outlet.
2. Plug the iron in and set the temperature control dial to the temperature required. Do not start ironing immediately.
3. Rest the iron on its heel for a few minutes until the light goes off before you start ironing.
4. The ready light will turn On and Off while you are ironing. This is normal. It shows that the iron is maintaining the heat setting you have set.
5. Begin with the fabrics that require the lowest heat settings (synthetics). Then move to heavier fabrics such as wool, cotton and linen.
6. Check with label on the garments for the correct ironing instructions, then turn on the temperature control dial to the setting required for desired fabric.
7. The iron heats up quicker than it cool down, so you'll save time and electricity. Use the iron evenly without strong pressure

1. Handle Cover
2. Temperature Control Dial
3. Housing
4. Cord Bush
5. Pilot Lamp Indicator
6. Sole Plate



IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

When using your flat iron, basic safety precautions should always be followed including the following:

1. Always set thermal control to OFF/MIN. position before plugging for use and before unplugging after use. Grasp plug to disconnect from AC outlet and do not yank cord.
2. Do not wet or immerse iron in water or any other liquid to prevent electric shock.
3. Do not allow the electric cord to touch hot surfaces.
4. Do not use iron when electric cord is damaged.
5. Do not repair or alter electrical connections by yourself. Refer servicing to a qualified technician or nearest authorized service centers.
6. If the cord is damaged, it must be replaced by 3D, any of its authorized service center or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid hazards.
7. This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children), with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
8. Children must be supervised to make sure that they do not play with the appliance.
9. Keep the appliance out of the reach of children
10. Iron must not be left unattended while it is connected to the supply mains.
11. The iron must be used and rested on a stable surface.
12. When placing on its stand, ensure that the surface of which the stand is placed is stable.
13. The iron is not to be used if it has been dropped or has a sign of damage or leaking.
14. This product is intended for indoor, household use only. Do not use outdoor or for commercial or industrial purposes.
15. Burns can occur from touching hot metal parts, use caution. To avoid a circuit overload, do not operate another high wattage appliance on the same circuit. If an extension cord is absolutely necessary, a 10 ampere cord should be used. Cords rated for less amperage may overheat. Care should be taken to arrange the cord so that it cannot be pulled or tripped over.

CARE AND STORAGE

- Never place the iron on a rough surface.
- Make sure the iron is cool and unplugged before cleaning. To keep the Sole Plate or the outside of your iron clean and free of lime, starch or other residue build up, stand the iron upright, make a paste of mild scouring powder and a little water. Apply a small amount to Sole Plate, rub gently and remove with a soft damp cloth. Wipe thoroughly with a clean cloth.
- Never use abrasive, steel wool, metal implements or other things which could scratch the surface. To clean off melted or man made fibre, set the iron to high temperature position and pass it over a clean piece of cotton which will draw the deposit of the surface.
- When you finish ironing, ensure the Temperature Control dial is in minimum position. Unplug from wall socket. Place the iron on its Heel and let it cool down. Wind the flex cord around the rear of the iron and store the iron safely on its heel.
